This is a vampy 'feel' 'groove' song. Jagger makes up the lyrics all the time, depending on the performance. It's pretty much how he wrote the lyrics, with not a lot of literary care (did he ever?)

The song is largely built on a constantly repeating chordal riff. Here we'll do it in F.

Main Riff

You can play it as just an **F** to **Dm**, but using strict single thumb strums.

If you want to play 'the riff', each F & Dm is preceded by a C6, with Bb ending the progression with two beats.

The Bridge is different.


